In our archdiocese, children baptized in the Roman Catholic Church celebrate Reconciliation in grade 2, Eucharist in grade 3 and Confirmation in grade 6. All children receiving sacraments in the 2023/2024 school year, whether they attend Catholic school or otherwise, must be registered online. You need to provide a copy of your child's baptism certificate to the parish office.



**Ezekiel 18:25 - 28.** Personal responsibility **Philippians 2:1 - 11.** Imitating Christ's humility **Matt. 21:28 - 32.** Parable of the two sons

**Key Passage:** A man had two sons; he went to the first and said, "Son, go and work in the vineyard today." He answered, "I will not"; but later he changed his mind and went. The father went to the second and said the same; and he answered, "I am going, sir"; but he did not go. Which of the two did the will of his father? They said, "The first."
